JOB DESCRIPTION:

The intern will be overseen by the Operations Manager, and will work scheduling artists and schools for two sessions of Music Scores, our main Youth Musical Education initiative. Will create and modify education programmes for local area schools. Will also work with the Artistic Director to schedule rehearsals for the three week Festival. Will liaise with teachers and artists to ensure a smooth transition. Will develop Music Scores Guidebook & lesson plans. Administrative duties as required with a focus on working with Artists, teachers and the Stockey Centre technical crew to ensure performances receive the appropriate attention and support. Will work with students to "plant the seeds", encouraging and promoting musical appreciation. Will promote the Festival with a focus on Family or All Ages concerts.

QUALIFICATIONS:

University or college graduate who has graduated within the last three years from an accredited college or university. The candidate must be a graduate of a post-secondary degree or diploma program. The position will be a first full-time employment in the candidate's field of study.

Education in teaching is required. Strong organization and interpersonal skills are a necessity.
